ENTRY & PEN FEES

ENTRY FEE is \$60 per goat for all six shows.

Any entry after 10 is free.

FREE entry for WETHERS.

The PEN FEE is \$18 per pen, \$10 per TACK PEN (no bedding). Fee includes set-up and 1 bag premium pine shavings per pen.

Show pens are 6x8, no climb fence and concrete slab. There are plenty of wash stations inside, including hot water. (Bring your own water hose.) Entire facility is enclosed.

Note: You must provide your own hay.

There will be a GIFT CARD given for the BEST COSTUME GOAT/HANDLER CONTEST following the afternoon shows on Saturday. All are encouraged to participate. The raffle will follow the costume contest.

Deadline for SHOW ENTRY FORMS is October 20th. Copies of MSFGA Registration Certificates must accompany all show entries.
Any entry submitted after October 20th will be accepted but will not be published in the show program.

PLEASE DO NOT send you entry forms via MESSENGER or TEXT. Either email your entries or use US mail.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Any goat exhibiting signs of infectious disease or symptoms of illness will not be permitted on the show grounds.

This determination will be at the discretion of the show superintendents. Registered goats with a registration tattoo number accompanied by registration papers and a Scrapie Eradication program premise ID number do not require a Scrapie ear tag.

Intrastate goats must have a registration certificate, a registration tattoo number, and a Scrapie Premise ID number.

SHOW RULES

Miniature Silky Fainting Goat Association rules shall govern this show. Refer to the MSFGA website: www.msfgaregistry.org for complete show rules. All goats entered in the show must be registered with the MSFGA.

Over height animals will not be permitted to compete in the show.

Does must not exceed 23.5" at the withers. Bucks must not exceed 25" at the withers.

All animals will be measured by an official measuring committee.

ARRIVAL/CHECK IN

Goats may arrive any time after 10 AM on Thursday, October 28th. All goats must be checked in and measured by Saturday at 8:00 AM.

RV PARKING

All RV parking fees are to be paid once you arrive at the show. A Will Rogers representative will be collecting your payment. Please indicate on your entry fee the number of nights you will need to reserve.

PARKING

There will be a \$5 parking fee per day per vehicle. An In & Out pass will be provided for each exhibitor.

Be sure to tell the parking attendant you are with the Yellow Rose of Texas Show.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded first through fourth place in all regular classes. Rosettes will be presented to Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and Best Wether in show winners. Rosettes and special awards will be presented to Best in Show winners.

BEST COSTUME for GOAT/HANDLER gift card will be awarded to the winner.

RAFFLE

There will be a raffle following the last two shows on Saturday. Tickets will be 15 tickets for \$20 or 6 tickets for \$10.
