

DIRECTIONS

Take I-30 to Ft. Worth, exit 12A onto University, go NORTH. Turn LEFT onto Trail Drive and go to GATE 42.
Make a left turn once in the parking lot to the SWINE BARN.

LODGING

There are many other hotels on I-30 that are minutes from the facility.

ENTRY & PEN FEES

ENTRY FEE IS \$80 per goat for all eight shows.

FREE entry for WETHERS.

The PEN FEE is \$18 per pen, \$10 per TACK PEN (no bedding). The fee includes set-up and 1 bag of premium pine shavings per pen. The show pens are 6x8, with no climb fence and concrete slab. There are plenty of wash stations inside, including hot water. (Bring your own water hose.) The entire facility is enclosed.

Note: You must provide your own hay.

It is recommended that you bring box fans if possible. Even though the barn is well-ventilated, the weather might be warmer than expected.

The deadline for SHOW ENTRY FORMS is August 25th. Copies of MSFGA Registration Certificates must accompany all show entries. Any entry submitted after August 25th will be accepted but will not be published in the show program. **ENTRY FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED VIA MESSENGER or TEXT. Either email your entries or use US mail.**

There will be no refunds for any reason.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Any goat exhibiting signs of infectious disease or symptoms of illness will not be permitted on the show grounds.

This determination will be at the discretion of the show superintendents. Registered goats with a registration tattoo number accompanied by registration papers and a Scrapie Eradication program premise ID number do not require a Scrapie ear tag.

Intrastate goats must have a registration certificate, a registration tattoo number, and a Scrapie Premise ID number.

SHOW RULES

Miniature Silky Fainting Goat Association rules shall govern this show. Refer to the MSFGA website:

www.msfgaregistry.org for

complete show rules. All goats entered in the show must be registered with the MSFGA. Over-height animals will not be permitted to compete in the show.

Does must not exceed 23.5" at the withers. Bucks must not exceed 25" at the withers.

All animals will be measured by an official measuring committee.

ARRIVAL/CHECK-IN

Goats may arrive any time after 10 AM on Thursday, September 7th. All goats must be checked in and measured by Saturday at 8:00 AM. Each animal to be exhibited will be checked off by the measuring committee once it has been measured. All owners must be present when the animal is being measured.

RV PARKING

\$30 per day (Includes water and electricity)

All RV parking fees are to be paid once you arrive at the show. A Will Rogers representative will be collecting your payment. Please indicate on your entry fee the number of nights you will need to reserve.

PARKING

There will be a \$6 parking fee per day per vehicle. An In & Out pass will be provided for each exhibitor.

Be sure to tell the parking attendant you are with the Yellow Rose of Texas Show.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded first through fourth place in all regular classes. Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st and 2nd places winners per show via a drawing. Rosettes will be presented to Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, and Best Wether in show winners. Rosettes and special awards will be presented to Best in Show winners.

RAFFLE

There will be a raffle following the last two shows on Saturday. Tickets will be 25 tickets for \$20.
